

Putting employee health first: CGF unveils 2023 Wellbeing campaign



As part of its commitment to empowering people to lead healthier lives while creating shared value for business and communities, The Consumer Goods Forum (CGF) has launched the *#Wellbeing at Work* campaign in 2023 through its Collaboration for Healthier Lives (CHL) Coalition of Action. This campaign puts employee health at the centre and encourages companies to actively promote and support the well-being of their workforce.

Focusing on the four pillars of the Workforce Nutrition framework, the campaign features

topics such as healthy food options at work, breastfeeding support, nutrition health checks, and nutrition education. GAIN's evidence briefs provide more information on the [evidence](#) supporting each of these common workforce nutrition interventions.

Enhancing existing workforce nutrition policies in Nigeria:

Latest "GAIN Policy Brief" outlines 11 opportunities for improvement



Nigeria has placed a major emphasis on recognizing the significance of workplaces in promoting good nutrition in recent years. The country's Food and Nutrition Security Strategy (2016-2025) and the National Health Promotion Policy (2019) highlight the importance of promoting healthy eating habits among workers. Nonetheless, additional policies are needed to start or scale up workforce nutrition programs and contribute to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.

To enhance policies on workforce nutrition, Gain's recent "Policy Brief" on Nigeria has provided eleven recommendations, including: incentivizing employers to subsidize healthy meal options at or near the workplace, specifying minimal nutritional requirements with nutrition services in relevant policies and requiring workers' representation in canteen management.
